The Billings Community Foundation was contacted to see what we could do to get the Fund moved back to Montana. After several months, phone calls and letters the Billings Community Foundation was proud to announce that the Fund was successfully moved back "home". It is now managed by Montanans who know where Harlowton is and who can be easily reached to answer any questions that might come up.
